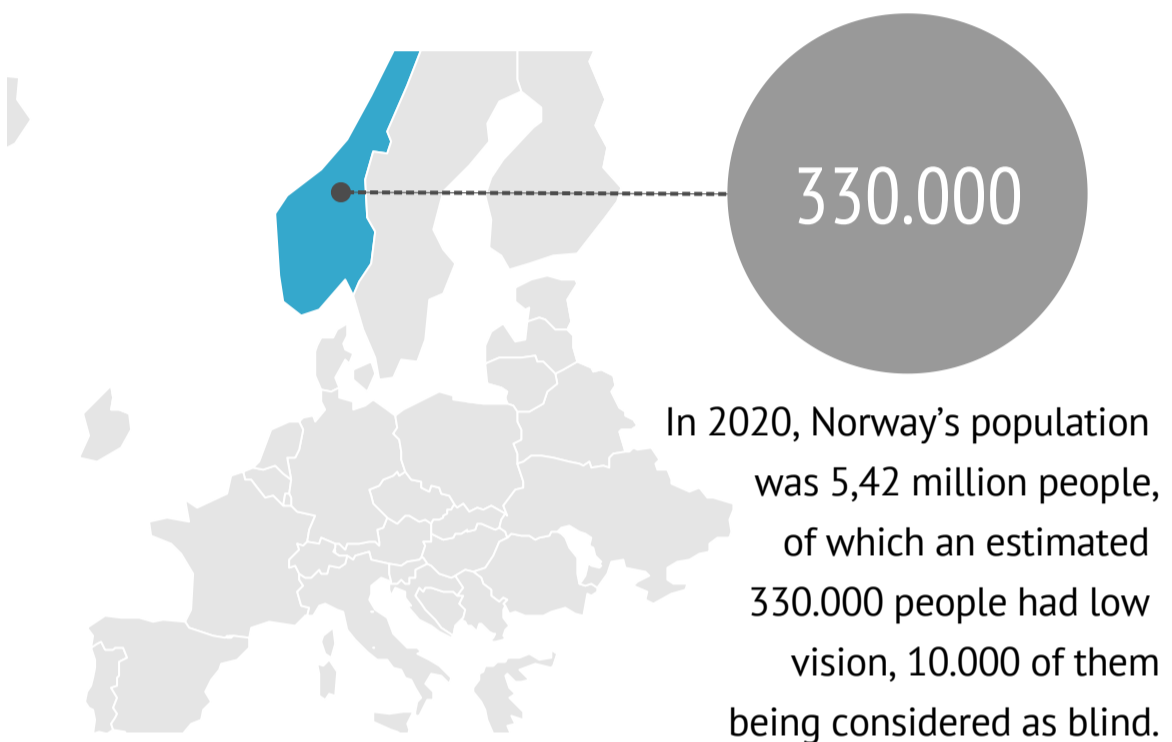


LOW VISION IN NORWAY

In 2021, there were 633.992 children in primary and secondary school in Norway, of whom 49.131 had special needs.



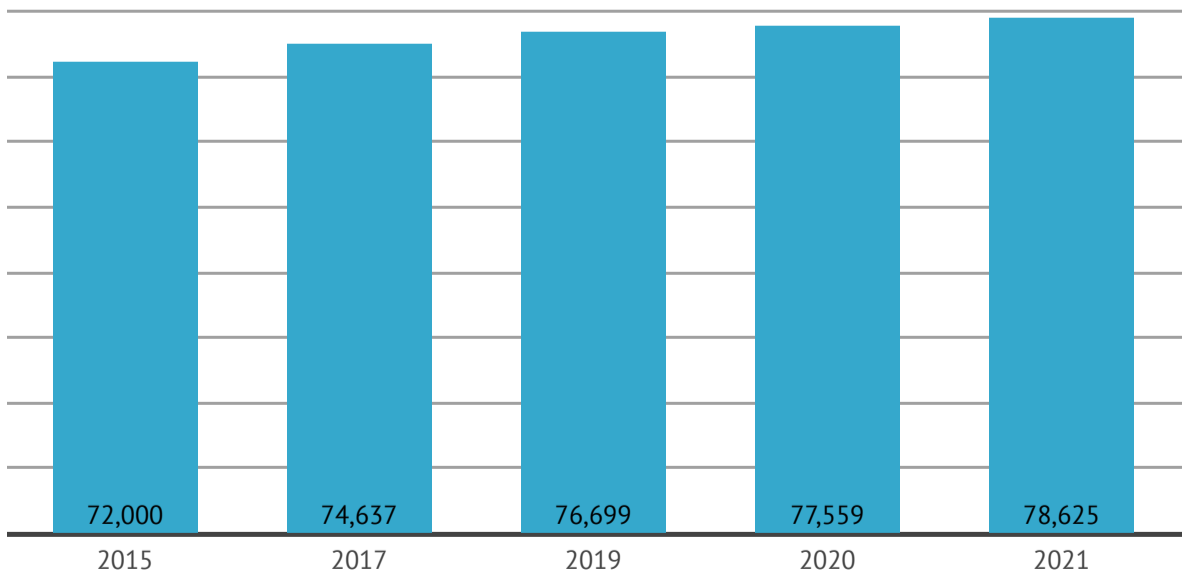
SECONDARY EDUCATION IN NORWAY
